TNR Workshop Instructor

Community Cats Toronto is a registered charity formed by a merger between Urban Cat Relief and Toronto Feral Cat Project. Community Cats Toronto's primary program is our monthly Trap Neuter Return workshop, which we facilitate on behalf of the Toronto Feral Cat Coalition's TNR program. We have trained and certified more than 2,100 colony managers so that they can TNR the cats in their colonies through the available free spay-neuter clinics to date.

As a Trap Neuter Return workshop instructor you will help facilitate our training sessions to the public across Toronto and the GTA along with another experienced facilitator and a registration desk volunteer. We are looking for energetic, passionate individuals who can become TNR experts and help answer questions about TNRing cats.

Our workshop size averages around 25 people. Trainings are held on the first Saturday of the month from 9:00am-2:00pm - this includes set-up and pack-up time after the training.

Access to a vehicle is not necessary but preferred as there is equipment that needs to be moved (traps, projector, workbooks and other training materials) and at least one volunteer per training needs to bring it. Ability to lift up to roughly 40lbs an asset.

Potential volunteers require a desire to help individuals who are helping the cats by providing advice and educational resources. They also must have an interest in teaching. Some teaching experience is desirable but not necessary.
